EMPLOYMENT ADVANCEMENT FOR TANF PARTICIPANTS-BEN-16-047

Program Description: The purpose of this TANF Competitive Grant is to provide proven service approaches and strategies that help current and former TANF clients (including those with multiple barriers) prepare to enter, succeed, and advance in the workplace. Four categories of TANF participants are served by the grants including VIEW, TANF, Diversionary and Transitional for up to two years after leaving the program. The intent is to provide resources to expand and enhance existing service delivery efforts to address more fully the needs of the TANF population prior to entry into work and during employment.

EMPLOYMENT FOR TANF PARTICIPANTS (PHASE 1) BEN-17-056

Program description: Competitive grants for community employment and training programs designed to move low-income families out of poverty through programs designed to help TANF recipients and other families living at or below 200% of the poverty level to obtain and retain competitive employment with the prospect of a career path and wage growth. There is a non-federal match requirement of 25%. A report is required on the following Cumulative Client Outcomes:

EMPLOYMENT FOR TANF PARTICIPANTS (PHASE 2) BEN-19-024

Program description: Additional funds for a second round of grants for community employment and training programs came out of the General Assembly in 2018 for SFY 2019-20. Non-federal match was reduced to 10% for grant recipients located in Virginia counties or cities with high fiscal stress as defined by the Commission on Local Government.

Contracts were awarded in January 2019 and have the same reporting requirements as Phase 1.




